

# What's in My Bag?

## a rhyming activity

Help your child practice rhyming with this simple, hands-on activity. With just a few everyday items and a bit of imagination, you have all the ingredients to create a memorable learning experience. Best of all, your child will discover that words are FUN!

### To Play

1. For this activity, you will need a bag and some household objects. Some suggestions are:

spoon	doll	brush
pen	key	ball
sock	shoe	clip
book	pan	form
cup	toy car	note
phone	cookie	letter

2. Put several items in the bag.
3. "We're going to play a rhyming game. You will pull items out of my bag and tell me the name of the item. Then you have to say a word that rhymes with it. This word can be a real word or a nonsense word. If you pull out a pen, you could say *hen*, or you could say a silly word like *nen!*"
4. Continue until your child has thought of rhyming words for every object.
